How and Where to Get Ultrasound

As a reminder, biopsy is the only test that can diagnose cancer. Every other test looks for signs consistent with cancer in its own unique way. For instance, thermograms study function/physiology, mammograms and ultrasounds study structure/anatomy. Thermograms visualize risk factors, i.e. hormonal imbalance, lymphatic congestion, inflammation, etc. not typically visible by most other tests. And even though they both study structure, mammograms and ultrasounds each study unique characteristics of structure not visible by thermograms. MRIs study both, anatomy and function. No test can detect every cancer.

If you think of each test as a piece of a puzzle, then each test adds to the complete puzzle, or picture and understanding of one's breast health. There are several other breast health tests as well. However, not every test is warranted for every individual. Many of our clients appreciate learning about Dr. McAleese at Women's Imaging Center, providing mammogram, ultrasound, MRI and biopsy. Dr. McAleese can explain the test most appropriate for your situation, based on thermobiological findings, personal and family history, and other factors.

ONLY Dr. McAleese respects and honors each woman's decision for ultrasound without a mammogram. (MRIs are typically more appropriate for higher-risk patients and those with increasing TH4+/5 ratings when structure/anatomy tests reveal nothing. Keep in mind:

- Whether you self-pay or intend to bill insurance, a prescription from your breast health provider will likely be required. If you do not already have a prescribing provider, consider holisticacare.com at 303-449-3777 for the prescription and care. Consider [Overcoming Ultrasound/Insurance Challenges](#) **for codes to add to your script so insurance might pay.**
- You will need to inform the Women's Imaging Center of the breast health provider who will be receiving your test results and providing follow-up care after testing. Appointments are contingent upon this information.
- You may need an MRI, not an ultrasound. Today's MRIs use an ionic form of gadolinium bound to a chelating molecule to *reduce* accumulation in the body. The doctors will discuss the rare risk of allergic reaction and will avoid MRI with certain kidney conditions.

For appointments: please call 303-321-2273 and say you are being referred by The Thermogram Center for Dr. McAleese ONLY. She only serves at their Cherry Creek location. Reminder: she needs to see your thermal imaging report/images, but we discourage you from giving the office the PDF file if your TH ratings are 3 or higher, as the information may be shared with the insurance industry and used against you RE: future life/health insurance applications. The office requires a script to bill insurance. You must have a health professional who can receive your ultrasound report. Reschedule if Dr. McAleese is unexpectedly absent, as the other doctors there are NOT supportive.
